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COLLEGE PRESENTATIONS

Presentations offer your students the opportunity to meet and engage with us, with the idea that this will reduce any worries or concerns they may have with engaging with figures outside of the school environment. They're also an ideal way for information to be shared with students, especially those who are still yet to decide what they plan to do post-16 or would benefit from a deeper understanding of the pathways they can choose from.

We're able to deliver presentations to your students who are in year 9, all the way up to those in year 13 cohorts. We can present these to whole year groups within an assembly, to smaller groups of students in a classroom setting or even virtually.

These presentations provide an insight into what college life is like, an overview of the different pathways available, the range of courses on offer, the enrichment and support supplied and much more. All of this helps to support students understanding of their next steps once they've left their current place of study.


PARENTS EVENINGS

CAREERS WORKSHOPS


Careers workshops are a fun and engaging way for your students to begin preparations ready for their move from school to their post-16 option.-
