## PRESENTATIONS AND ASSEMBLIES

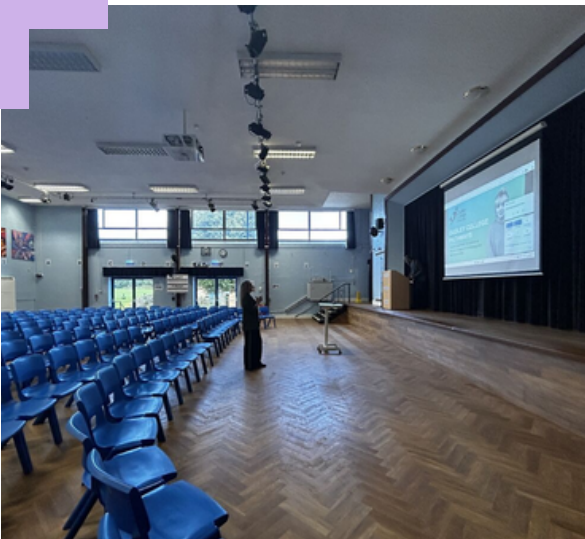
Assemblies are a great way to introduce students to their post-16 options. We cover available courses, different pathways, our facilities, and provide a real insight into what college life is like.
